Brothers in Christ,

This month we celebrate the 250th Anniversary of the founding of our country. The Catholic Church holds a unique place in the cultural and spiritual landscape of the United States. Catholics have played a significant role

in shaping the United States from its earliest days, often overcoming suspicion and discrimination to contribute meaningfully to national life. One of the most influential early figures was Charles Carroll, the only Catholic signer of the Declaration of Independence. His presence among the Founding Fathers symbolized the possibility of religious pluralism in a nation still wrestling with its identity. Carroll's advocacy for liberty and civic virtue helped pave the way for Catholics to participate fully in American public life.

As the nation grew, so did the Catholic community, thanks largely to waves of immigration from Ireland, Germany, Italy, Poland, and beyond. These communities produced leaders whose impact extended far beyond the Church. St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, the first American-born saint, founded the country's first Catholic school system, laying the groundwork for what would become one of the largest private educational networks in the world. Dorothy Day, co-founder of the Catholic Worker Movement, became a prophetic voice for social justice, labor rights, and the dignity of the poor—her influence still resonates in contemporary discussions about faith and public responsibility. Our own founder, Blessed Fr.

Michael J. McGivney, worked in his day to improve the lot of immigrants, starting with the Irish, in his own parish of St. Mary's in New Haven, CT. The Knights of Columbus has since become the largest Catholic fraternal organization in the world.

The 20th century also saw Catholicism enter the highest levels of American political and cultural life. Figures such as John F. Kennedy, the first Catholic president, helped normalize Catholic participation in national leadership, while religious leaders like Cardinal James Gibbons and Archbishop Fulton Sheen shaped public discourse on morality, labor, and media.

Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception is our nation's patroness. The U.S. bishops formally declared her patroness in 1846, a decision later approved by Pope Pius IX. This title reflects both a deep devotion to Mary and a desire to anchor the young nation's Catholic identity in a figure symbolizing purity, hope, and divine protection.

Let us all pray that our country continues to be a beacon of light in the world. Let us pray that we build on the legacy of our country's Catholic leaders, especially Fr. McGivney, as we put our Catholic faith into action. **Mary, patroness of America, pray for us.**

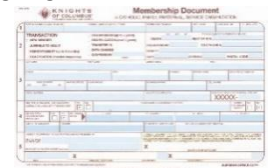

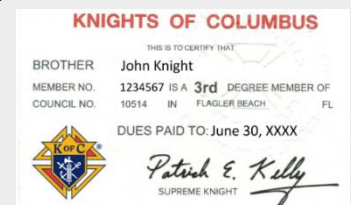

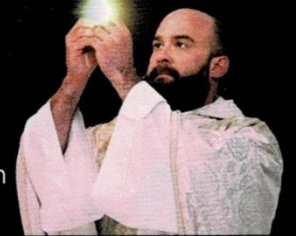

District Deputy Greg Gully recognized Past Grand Knight Bryant Perszyk for outstanding achievements that were accomplished by Notre Dame Council 10514 on a state level during the 2025-26 fraternal year. The Florida State Council presented plaques and awards to the council for seven categories during the recent state convention in Orlando. There were four plaques awarded in the LIFE category: LIFE ACTIVITIES AWARD (1st Place), STATE SERVICES PROGRAMS AWARD – LIFE (1st Place), FAITH IN ACTION – LIFE AWARD, & ULTRASOUND GOLD AWARD. The

council also received the COUNCIL ACTIVITIES AWARD – FAMILY (3rd Place) and the MEMBERSHIP AWARD (3rd Place) by achieving 207% of membership quota.

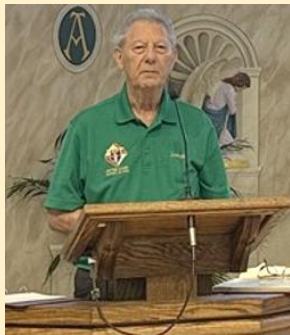

St. Mary Cemetery Spiritual Meditation Plaza Dedicated

A newly constructed Cemetery Spiritual Meditation Plaza was recently dedicated at St. Mary Catholic Cemetery in Bunnell, Florida. The dedication ceremony was held in conjunction with the annual Memorial Day Veteran Remembrance ceremony at the cemetery.

The construction of the plaza was a result of consultation with the Director of Catholic Cemeteries for the Diocese of St. Augustine, Keith Rezendes, and KofC members. It was felt that a place for family members and guests to sit and quietly pray at the cemetery would be spiritually beneficial to those visiting the cemetery as well those souls interred in their final resting place. The plaza would also be a visual enhancement to the aesthetics of the overall cemetery.

A member of Notre Dame Council 10514 donated the funds to purchase the bricks and other materials needed for the project. Past Faithful Navigator Richard Friese assisted Deputy Grand Knight and master mason, Bruce Zarajczyk, in the actual construction of the plaza. Traditional bricks

were used to build the walls and seating area. A donation of floor pavers was installed on the ground in front of the seating area. Planters were built into each of the side walls so that flowers and small plants could be added.

Color Corp members from Corpus Christi Assembly 2810 (Flagler Beach) and Fr. John McElroy Assembly 4069 (Palm Coast) were led by Color Corp Commander Chris Daley at the dedication and remembrance ceremony. Sir Knight Deacon John Harvey opened the dedication with the invocation. He was followed by Sir Knight Deacon Steve Johnson invoking God's blessing with benediction prayers.

The newly constructed plaza continues the commitment by the Knights of Columbus to beautify St. Mary Cemetery. The Knights in District 17 have previously trimmed trees, removed brush, and cleaned fence lines on the cemetery grounds. This commitment allows the Knights to put Faith in Action by performing the Spiritual and Corporal Works of Mercy by praying for and burying the dead.

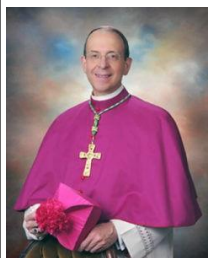

"While everyone was asleep his enemy came and sowed weeds all through the wheat, and then went off. When the crop grew and bore fruit, the weeds appeared as well." (Gospel for July 19, Mt 13:25-26)

In the midst of his suffering, Job asked, "Why do the wicked keep on living, grow old, become mighty in power?" (Job 21:7). It seems to human eyes an injustice: the good suffer while the evil prosper. But Jesus explains that God "makes his sun rise on the bad and the good, and causes rain to fall on the just and the unjust" (Mt 5:45). He is a patient

God, and we must "consider the patience of our Lord as salvation" (2 Pt 3:15a). God is patient with sinners — including us.

This month, I challenge you to reach out to a family member or friend and invite them to go to the sacrament of penance.

Questions for Reflection:

- In what way are you like wheat, and in what ways are you like weeds?
- Are you envious or disturbed by those who lead unholy lives but seem to prosper?
- Do you find it difficult to love the "weeds" in your life, to pray for and work toward their salvation?

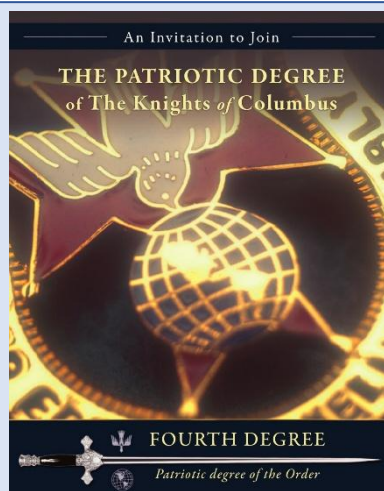
