Did you know that in August, the month of his feast day, was full of honors and devotion to Father McGivney?

- At the 143rd Supreme Convention in Washington, D.C., the Knights of Columbus honored Father Frank Donio with the annual Blessed Michael McGivney medal. Father Donio, who has been a Knight for more than 40 years, serves as D.C. state chaplain and chaplain of The Catholic University of America Council 9542. You can hear his story in this [video tribute of his work](#).
- At the convention's opening Mass, a banner of Father McGivney hung in front of the majestic Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception, where a McGivney statue graces the Hall of American Saints on the lower level.
- Pope Leo XIV sent a [video message to the Knights](#), in which he acknowledged Blessed Michael's example of how Catholics must be "tangible signs of hope" to the world.
- The convention's annual Memorial for All Deceased Knights of Columbus was offered as a Votive Mass of Blessed Michael McGivney by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William Lori of Baltimore. As the necrology was read of K of C leaders who had died in the past year and those assembled prayed for their souls, one could imagine Father McGivney interceding for his brother Knights.
