Bingo Update



As we start the final trimester of our fiscal year 2025/2026 Bingo year, we can look at some numbers to compare how we did this year as compared to last year. In terms of raw numbers, we have had 27 bingo Sundays this year as compared to 16 Sundays FY 2024-2025. Gross income from Bingo this time last year was just over \$15,100, as compared to over \$31,000 in gross receipts this fiscal year. In terms of average number of players, we averaged 72 payers while this year we have averaged about 79 players per week. This is a testament to what type of entertainment our teams give to the community. Thank you!

We will take off Bingo for the Confirmation retreat February 1, and again on February 15 for the parish picnic. March will be a full month, except that on Pam Sunday we will start Bingo at 2 pm vice the normal 1 pm start.

Bingo doors open at noon on Sunday, and first game starts at 1:00 p.m. The games currently last until 4 to 4:15, so it is not an all-day affair.

Please consider volunteering to help with Bingo. Brother Pasquale Volpe has lightened my load by organizing front table personnel, and **he could use some more brothers** to set up a rotational schedule. **We welcomed two new volunteers in January, Brian Benninger and Sam Moorhead, but additional volunteers are needed to set up 4 complete teams.** Just 1 and a half hours after the 10:30 mass on Sunday at Holy Redeemer. **We would also like to train an additional cashier.** It really isn't that challenging. Lead cashier needs to be there by 10:30 (to ensure they can get a parking spot), assist in setting up the cashier tables with early card sales help. Once the doors open, the lead cashier sells the game packs, and once the games start, divvy out the money for the winners, and is there to close the books when Bingo is over. Card sales can use some help, for 11:30 to 1 (contact Pat Volpe), and afternoon floor help from 1 pm to close.

If you would like me to stop pleading at the meetings and in this publication, please give Pat Volpe or myself a call or a text. All we are asking for is a commitment of a couple of hours per month. While I do sincerely appreciate those gentlemen who come in week after week, I am appealing to our other brother Knights. We have over 300 gentlemen in our order, yet fewer than 10 percent help on a routine basis. Please prayerfully consider using some of your time (and talent) to spread charity and goodwill to our biggest charitable event. Please help us keep alive the first pillar of the Knights of Columbus – Charity. Please let me know if you would like to help!

The Holy See Announces the Appointment of the Rev. Manuel de Jesús Rodríguez, LL.B., J.C.D. as Sixth Bishop of Palm Beach.

Pope Leo XIV has appointed Father Manuel de Jesús Rodríguez, currently pastor of Our Lady of Sorrows Parish, Corona (Queens), New York, as the sixth Bishop of Palm Beach. The bishop-elect succeeds Bishop Gerald M. Barbarito, who has served the diocese since 2003.

A native of the Dominican Republic, Bishop-Elect Rodríguez was ordained to the priesthood July 3, 2004, in Santo Domingo, and became affiliated with (incardinated into) the **Diocese of Brooklyn**, New York, on June 29, 2012. He is a canon lawyer with extensive experience in penal canon law and pastoral leadership. Besides his parish responsibilities in Queens, he serves in senior juridical roles in the Brooklyn Diocese, including promoter of justice and delegate of the diocesan bishop for penal cases. Bishop-Elect Rodríguez is fluent in four languages (English, Spanish, Italian and French).

With the announcement of Bishop-Elect Rodríguez's appointment, Bishop Barbarito assumes the status of Bishop Emeritus of Palm Beach. He also becomes the Apostolic Administrator of the Diocese of Palm Beach until the day of Bishop-Elect Rodríguez's ordination and installation.






