## SARASOTA MEDICAL PREGNANCY CENTER (SMPC)



Brother Art Reilly serves as an ambassador and Committee member for Sarasota Medical Pregnancy Center in a variety of capacities. During June among other things, he

- Chaired the SMPC Board's July 21st Medical and Educational Services Committee meeting and participated with staff and others in discussing the range of Center services, including:
- Large number of additions to staff
- Staff training, including on shared-decision making and motivational interviewing
- Approval by the Sarasota County Commission of a significant grant for behavioral health services (photo nearby of Art addressing the 7/8/25 Commission before grant approval)
- Presentation of the risks of self-medicating to pregnant women
- Upcoming Center receipt of a 26-foot mobile medical unit and a draft initial deployment plan to serve underserved moms at remote locations
- Discussion of recent events increasing the need for Center services, e.g. defunding of Planned Parenthood and studies of the significant risks from the use of abortion pills
- Initial data from a marketing study of Center website effectiveness, opportunities for improvement and near-term plans for improving site
- Described the initial plans for the SMPC

Mobile Medical Unit and its role in better serving the community at the July KofC Council meetings at Incarnation and St Patrick's Churches. Several Knights indicated an interest in volunteering to serve as drivers for the mobile unit. A presentation on this is scheduled for the August St Thomas More KofC Council meeting.

I believe we're making Blessed Michael McGivney proud. We celebrate his feast day on August 13, so this month is a fitting time to ask his continued intercession for our work.

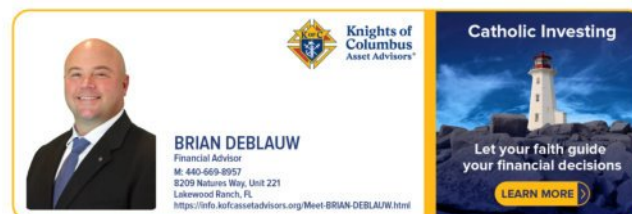
In founding the Knights, Father McGivney

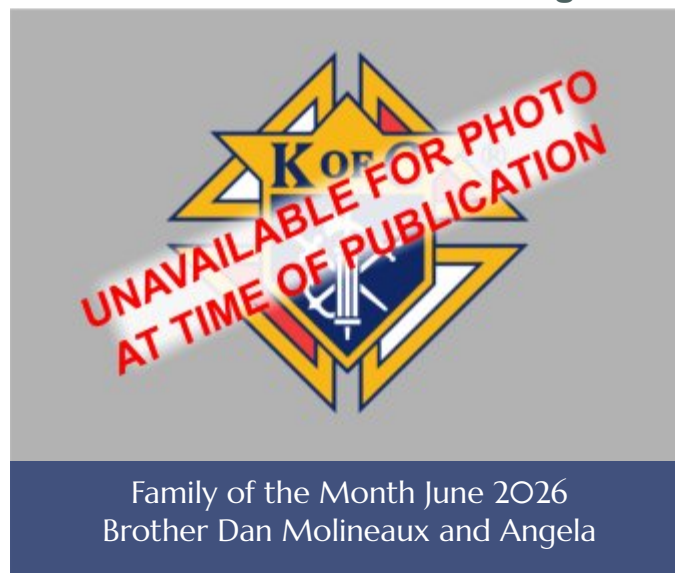

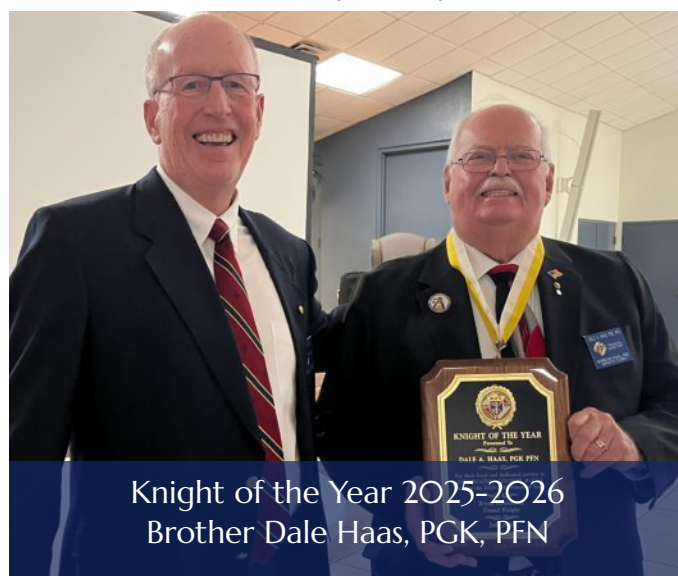
